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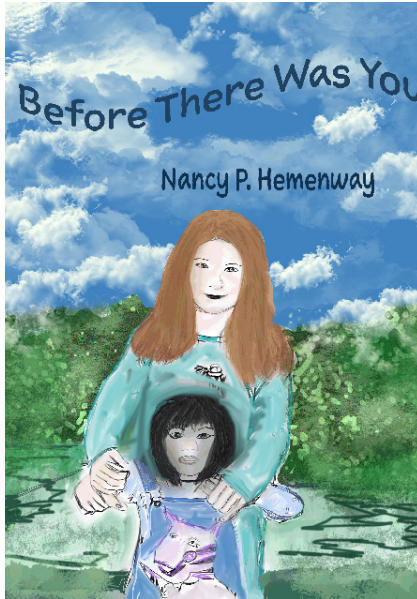
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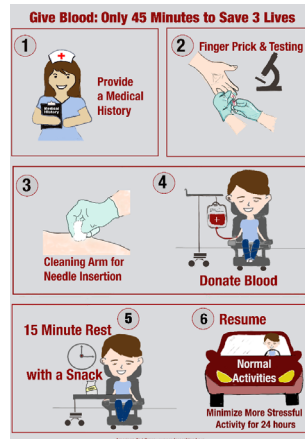

INCIID Program Keeps Hope Alive
For this couple, the hope of having their child was never lost. After several years of trying, they finally became pregnant. The first 17 weeks went well but during a routine ultrasound in Julia's second trimester, the doctor diagnosed the couple's baby with a severe congenital diaphragmatic hernia with only a 30% chance of survival.

Julia describes her first delivery as the best and worst day of her life. Parker took his last breath in his daddy's arms at 2:15 pm the same day he came into the world.

A Miracle After 8 Miscarriages
Dean and Karmann came to the INCIID Heart Program after years of struggling through 8 miscarriages. He had all hope and a miracle at 14 weeks. Finally, little Kai was born. Karmann told INCIID, "I don't know if it's everything and more. We would NEVER have been parents and allowed to have this boy if not for the support of the INCIID Heart Program. Our insurance would not cover it and our health insurance would not be able to afford it."



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
